• 15 units (5 courses), credential on transcript

- Provides an interdisciplinary foundation in disability studies, physical activity, health and their intersection while fostering fundamental academic skills
- Lecture + case-based coursework, technology-enhanced modules, and unique experiential learning opportunities with the Revved Up Adapted Exercise Program

- Develop a deeper understanding of what it means for people to live with a disability/chronic disease and how physical activity can improve their quality of life
- Strengthen communication and leadership skills
- Develop exercise prescription skills with a focus on considerations for people with a disability, and perform program reassessments on Revved Up participants

- Certificate comprised of 15.0 units (5 courses)
- 6.0 units (2 courses) double count towards your degree
- 9.0 extra units (3 courses) for the certificate
- ~\$2,000 based on 2019-2020 FAS unit fees

- Must be enrolled in an undergrad program on Queen's campus
- Grade cut off of 2.7 GPA to apply
- Limited number of spots available each year
