#### Questions about the P/ passing grade for Winter 2020?

A “P” credit will not affect your GPA. You will earn credit towards your degree, but the course will not be included in the calculation of your GPA.

P grades can be requested for any classes – core, option, supporting, electives, etc. However, please be aware that certain prerequisites require specific grades and in these cases a P credit would not be sufficient. It’s important to look closely at the prerequisites for courses in your degree plan before making a decision to designate a course as P. You should also take caution when selecting a P credit for courses that could affect your plan selection (first-year students) or a potential future change in plan for upper year students (e.g., a P credit in HLTH 101 will not be sufficient to be accepted into any Health Studies plan).

An example for plan selection: if you are considering designating PSYC 100 as a “P” and your desired major is Health Studies, it would have no effect on your admission into HLTH (we only consider your grade in HLTH 101 and your cumulative GPA). However, if, for example, you wished to become a Health Studies and Psychology Medial, you would need a minimum grade of a B- in PSYC 100 to be considered eligible for admission. Please also take into consideration possible grade requirements in prerequisite courses for graduate programs.

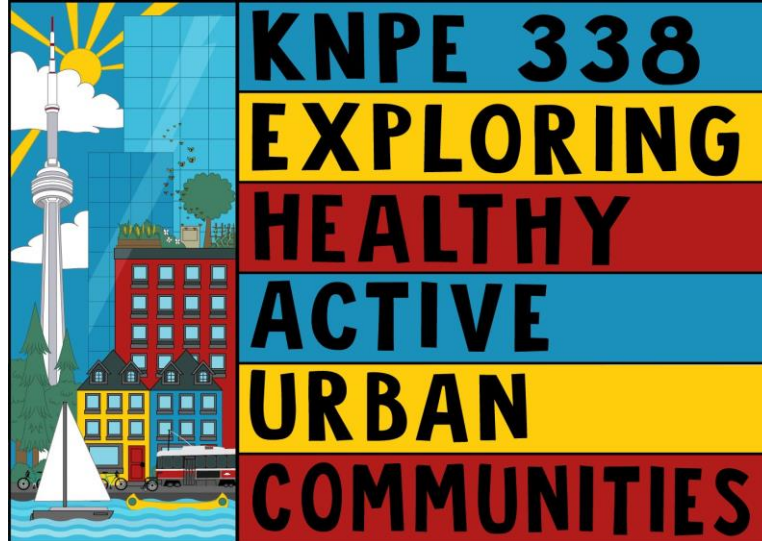
