## Registration Timelines mark these dates in your calendar!

Date	Action
June 24	Fall/Winter Course Timetable available on SOLUS
July 15	Students access the Student Centre to view enrollment appointment times and begin loading classes into shopping cart on SOLUS
July 24	Appointment times issued to 4 <sup>th</sup> year students (LEVEL 4 = 84 units)
July 25	Appointment times issued to all 3 <sup>rd</sup> year students
July 30	Registration Pause Day
July 31	Second enrollment appointment – student are limited to 15 units/term in July including 1 waitlisted course
August 19	Open enrollment begins – students may add 18 units/term including 2 waitlisted courses

# Registration Guidelines:

## Reserves & Waitlists:

- Some courses e.g. HLTH 230 are reserved for students in a certain plan/level. You will have to wait until reserves are lifted (e.g., **July 27<sup>th</sup>** for some HLTH courses or **July 31<sup>st</sup>**) or open enrollment (**August 19**)
- Unfortunately, reserves are lifted at different times (BHSC, Online, Departmental). We will do our best to communicate those dates closer to registration.
- You may be able to put yourself on the waitlist. You can only be on 1 waitlist until Aug.19 and your waitlisted course counts towards your 15 units.
- Once the reserve capacity expires, students on the waitlist will be enrolled (if there is space).

## Registration Guidelines, cont'd:

### 4<sup>th</sup> year registration:

- All 4<sup>th</sup> year HLTH & KIN students will receive the same enrollment time on **July 24<sup>th</sup>**
- You will be responsible for registering yourself into HLTH 416, plus the minimum option courses required to graduate. For most students it will be 6 units at the 400 level.
- If you are enrolled in an Independent Research Course (HLTH 491/3.0, HLTH 456/3.0, HLTH 595/6.0) these will count towards your HLTH options.

Do not enrol in more 400-level courses than you need to graduate during your appointment time! We will be monitoring student registrations and may remove you from a course if we need the seat for another student.

# Core & Option Courses

## Health Year 3

### Core:

- HLTH 305 – Fundamentals of Health Policy
- HLTH 315 – Theory & Practice of Health Behaviour Change
- HLTH 323 – Epidemiology

### Options:

- HLTH 334 – Health, Illness & Society
- 6 units of HLTH options at the 300 level

If there are time conflicts between courses you'd like to take, decide which is a priority for this year and what can wait until 4<sup>th</sup> year.

Are there any community or research-based courses that you'd like to take? Do your research! Some require applications (e.g., HLTH 300, HLTH 352).

# Core & Option Courses

## Health Year 4

### Core:

- HLTH 416 – Program Planning and Evaluation
- HLTH 315\* – Theory & Practice of Health Behaviour Change

\* we will allow students to take these concurrently for students in 4<sup>th</sup> year

### Options:

- 6 units of HLTH options at the 400 level
- HLTH 334\* – Health, Illness & Society

\* if you didn't take either HLTH 333 or 334 in 3<sup>rd</sup> year

If you require a reference for a graduate program, look for small or independent courses where you will get to know the instructor.



# Health Options

- Remember there are many courses offered in other departments with a health focus that will count towards the options category
- Just because a HLTH course is full doesn't mean you can't fulfill the options category.

## **Some examples:**

HIST 228 – Global History of Pandemics

ECON 243 – The Economics of Health Care

GPHY 336 – Geography, the Environment & Human Health

# Electives

- For a HLTH Major, students require 60 units of electives
- Determine how many you want to take in 3<sup>rd</sup> year and how many you require to finish your degree for 4<sup>th</sup> year
- Electives can be any in any year and any department in Arts & Sciences
- When choosing electives, choose courses that both **interest you** and where you **have the ability** to learn (abilities, strengths, competencies). That's when you do your best work!

**Remember: you can only take 6 units of courses from outside of the Faculty of Arts and Science (BMED, COMM, GLPH, NURS, ENG, LAW)**

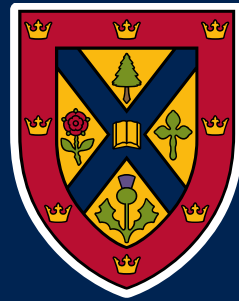
